GENERAL INFORMATION

Lighthouse Christian Academy (LCA) implements the A.C.E.* (Accelerated Christian Education) curriculum. Students learn at their own pace and may move ahead rapidly or take as long as necessary depending on their ability and motivational level. Graduates from the A.C.E.* program are attending more than 1,000 colleges and universities globally with outstanding performances. Each year the number of graduates increases. Students tend to function in the upper portion of their classes, scoring high when compared to others.

MISSION STATEMENT

LCA is a ministry that has been called to provide a Christ-centered education for children. Our mission is to prepare students for the world today by giving them the academic and spiritual tools necessary to achieve their God-given potential. Our goal is to reach the world for Christ, one child at a time, by providing Biblically-based educational materials and services for all students.

PHILOSOPHY

The philosophy of LCA is that students be given Christian-based instruction that prepares them to excel in basic and lifetime skills while upholding Biblical standards and high moral conduct. Students explore truths about God and His word, His character, and His wisdom without being pressured to keep up with the group.

CURRICULUM

A.C.E. is an individualized program allowing each student to work at his/her academic level of achievement. The program is divided into a four core curriculum subjects (math, English, science, social studies) as mandated by the state of Florida, and required elective subjects that fulfill essential educational needs. High school students are offered four courses of study: Honors, College, General, and Vocational. A teacher's role is to supervise and assist any student in mastering a particular skill. Students must test 80% or better before advancing to the next skill. To ensure learning in this self-contained system, all booklets include activity questions covering the material presented. Cognitive questions stimulate the student's mind. He/she is guided into thinking logically and Biblically. Tutoring is available upon request.

TESTING

The Stanford Achievement Test (SAT-10) is administered during the school year. This achievement test serves as a pretest before beginning more advanced English, math, social studies, and science levels. Annual testing results demonstrate that students are achieving an education comparable with, or superior to, education in public and secular private institutions. Completed tests are returned to Harcourt for computer scoring to enhance the credibility of the testing program.

ADMISSION POLICIES

LCA is a non-denominational educational institution that admits students of any race, color, national and ethnic origin to all the rights, privileges, programs, and activities generally accorded or made available to students at the Academy. It does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, national and ethnic origin in the administration of its educational policies, admissions policies, scholarship and loan programs, athletic and other Academy-administered programs. Chapel is scheduled once a week with the entire student body expected in attendance. Students are required to attend a church on a regular basis and parental support is paramount. Success is achieved with the combined efforts of students, teachers, and parents. LCA is not equipped to meet the needs of students with excessive learning difficulties or extensive social problems. A probation period is required before a student can be considered fully enrolled, and re-evaluation is determined periodically. Administration has the right to refuse any student who is uncooperative in all matters related to school policies.

ENROLLMENT REQUIREMENTS

LCA is an independent school sharing space provided by First Baptist Church of Oakland Park. All families entering our institution should have a home church. New families entering without a home church are strongly encouraged to attend worship service at First Baptist Church of Oakland Park.
